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ADOT Traffic Guidelines and Processes (TGPs) are provided as a guide for department personnel and consultants for traffic studies, operations, and design. The TGPs are not intended to be all-encompassing documents on traffic engineering, and are not intended to be a substitute for engineering knowledge, experience, or judgment.

The TGPs were developed for application on the Arizona State Highway System but not local roads and streets. Local jurisdictions may use the TGPs as a guide if they so desire.

The most recent approved and published edition of each TGP supersedes any previous TGPs, technical guidelines, or technical memoranda that may have been previously disseminated on the topic covered by that TGP.

The current approved editions of the following publications and documents are used in conjunction with the TGPs:
